Why are heirloom seeds essential for our survival? Get hands-on with seed saving and learn how you can keep the generations growing.

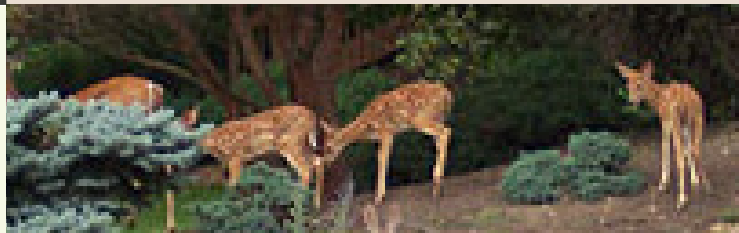


March 23d—Composting:
